



How to make your very own Pictureplate!

- ✓ Use strong, bold markers or texta pens, paints, craft dyes and good quality photos.
- ✓ Don't use pencils, crayons, metallics, fluoros or glitter.
- ✓ Glue your photos in place well. Large, bright close-up photos are best as they will slightly blur and darken during manufacture.
- ✓ Don't roll, fold or crease the paper.

Do your drawing inside this area. Up to 2cm will be trimmed off during manufacture.
