## How to make your very own iPhone 6 case!

- ✓ Use strong, bold markers or texta pens, paints, craft dyes and good quality photos.
- ✓ Don't use pencils, crayons, metallics, fluoros or glitter.
- ✓ Glue your photos in place well. Large, bright close-up photos are best as they will slightly blur and darken during manufacture.
- ✓ Don't roll, fold or crease the paper.
- ✓ Be sure to draw the right way up or your picture will be upside-down on the phone case.
- ✓ Up to ½cm will be trimmed from the inside of the drawing area during manufacture, but please don't draw a pencil guide line as it will show up on your finished product.
- ✓ Print this page on clean white A4 paper. Some recycled papers can show small black spots which will appear on your finished product, so avoid these papers.
- ✓ This paper is for iPhone 6 and iPhone 6S only. Download templates for other phones and products from [www.pictureproducts.com.au/drawing-paper](http://www.pictureproducts.com.au/drawing-paper)
