Overview of the role:

This Health and Physical Education teacher will teach Physical Education within the Classical Christian educational goals of the School. The teacher will be a dedicated and inspiring Christian educator, committed to incorporating a distinctly Christian world and life view in their teaching. As a collaborative member of our staff, they will joyfully support our shared calling to cultivate excellence in learning. The successful candidate will be both a qualified HDPE teacher with experience in teaching Years K to 6, and coordinating sports events. They will actively contribute to the life of the school—not only in the classroom, but also through co-curricular engagement, and participation in broader school community events.

The Physical Education teacher will design and implement a health and physical education program that involves teaching Physical Education within a classical Christian pedagogy which focuses not merely on physical skills and sports knowledge but also intentionally seeks to develop students with godly virtues such as temperance, self-control, diligence, endurance, courage, and so on, all to the glory of God. The role involves fostering a love for physical activity while connecting it to the broader goals of a Christ-centred education.

Key Responsibilities:

- Develop and deliver a physical education curriculum rooted in classical Christian education principles, emphasising the integration of historical frameworks and the cultivation of virtues such as discipline, teamwork, and perseverance.

- Plan and execute lessons that emphasize skill development, physical fitness, and character formation.
- Integrate historical and philosophical perspectives on physical education into teaching practices.
- Collaborate with other educators to ensure the physical education program complements the classical Christian curriculum.
- Whole school carnival coordination that includes organising and running carnivals and overseeing the preparation of teams for interschool competitions.
- Organise and oversee extracurricular activities, including sports teams and historical reenactments.
- Assess and monitor student progress, providing feedback to students and parents.
- Promote a safe and inclusive environment for all students.

All team members at CCS are required to have:

- Appropriate qualifications
- TQI registration
- A valid ACT Working with Vulnerable People Card
- Full working rights within Australia.

This role could be combined with other teaching roles including but not limited to Years 7 - 10 PDHPE (up to 1.0 FTE) subject to the School's requirements and the applicant's qualifications.
