The TAS teacher will cultivate a love of craftsmanship, problem-solving, design, and innovation, helping students to see the beauty, order, and purpose of God's creation through their studies.

# **Key Responsibilities**

- Teach Years 7–10 TAS subjects (including Woodwork, Design and Technology, and/or Industrial Technology) with a focus on hands-on learning and Christian worldview integration.
- Plan and deliver engaging lessons that align with the **Australian Curriculum** while embedding biblical principles of stewardship, creativity, and service.
- Create and maintain a safe and orderly classroom and workshop environment in line with WHS requirements.
- Foster habits of diligence, precision, and excellence in both theory and practical work.
- Model and encourage a Christian character that reflects Christ in word and action, mentoring students in faith and learning.
- Assess and provide feedback on student learning in line with ACT and school requirements.
- Collaborate with colleagues to support cross-disciplinary projects and contribute to the broader life of the school.
- Actively participate in staff devotions, prayer, and the spiritual community of the school.

#### **Essential Criteria**

- A sound profession of faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour, evidenced by active involvement in a Protestant church.
- Accredited teaching qualifications and current (or eligible) TQI registration.
- Demonstrated ability to teach across Years 7–10 TAS subjects in line with the Australian Curriculum.
- Practical expertise in one or more TAS disciplines (e.g., wood, metal, food, textiles, design, or ICT).
- A willingness to learn, grow, and actively engage in Classical Christian education.
- Obtain and/or maintain the ACT Working With Vulnerable People card.
- Strong communication and classroom management skills.
